CRIPPLE CREEK PARKS AND RECREATION

Mountain Wave Skate Park: Skaters, boarders, scooters and bikers can test their skills at this free park. Mountain Wave is located on Masonic Avenue adjacent to the basketball court, near Henry C. "June" Hack Community Center.

Mountain View BMX Track: Bike away on this free BMX Track located approximately one mile past Cripple Creek Public Works on County Rd 89.

Roller Skating and Blading: During the spring and winter indoor arena games and skating are held each weekend at the Henry C. "June" Hack Community Center. Please contact Parks and Recreation at 719-689-3514 for program dates/times.

Playground, Picnic, Basketball Court: Kids can run and play in the playground with climbing walls, tunnels, swings and slides. When playing in City Park visitors may checkout toys and equipment.

Theme and Skating Parties: Parks and Recreation offers theme parties and package deals. All party packages include games, roller skates, music and fun.

Open Arena: Visit the arena and enjoy skating, roller blading, foosball, air hockey, ping-pong and much more.

Kids Rock University: (K.R.U.) is a licensed childcare program dedicated to children 5 through 15 years old. The program is held at Cresson Elementary School, Monday through Thursday from 4 - 6:30 p.m. Each Adventure Friday from 7:15 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. K.R.U. offers a full-day field trip or activities. WINTER MEANS PENGUIN HOCKEY!

Victor kids know where to hang out in the winter - Brian's Park is the only groomed ice rink in southern Teller County and is open daily from mid December into early March.

Just off Portland Avenue in Victor, the rink is home to the Victor Penguins Hockey Club. Three divisions play on the rink, from Pee Wee, High School and Adults. Open skating is also available daily for those who are not into the sport. The rink is operated and maintained by the volunteer hockey club with a cooperative agreement with the City of Victor.
